Visa and Identification Requirements:					
Visa requirements	Citizens of the European Union, member states of the European Economic Area and Swiss Confederation may enter the Republic of Latvia without a visa and stay in Latvia for up to 90 days within a sixmonth period, counting from the day of entry. Citizens from other countries need a long-term visa for exchange students. (http://www.pmlp.gov.lv/en/home/services/visas-and-invitations/#1) A temporary residence permit is necessary for all students who are willing to stay in Latvia longer than 90 days. (http://www.pmlp.gov.lv/en/home/services/residence-permits/#1) Document confirming the necessary subsistence - required amount is EUR 360 per month.
