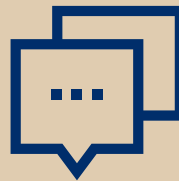

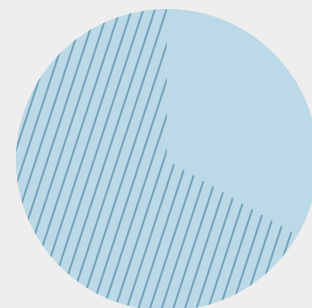

FINANCIAL MATTERS

The tuition fee is EUR 6650 yearly. Students from Latvia, Lithuania and Estonia receive a **scholarship of EUR 2100** reducing the tuition fee to EUR 4550 per year

- The tuition fee can be financed through loans guaranteed by SSE Riga or also by the State
- The average SSE Riga graduate repays the loan within 6.5 years

Did you know that 1 in 4 first-year students receive a scholarship that covers partial or full tuition fee for one to three years?

35 scholarships were granted to newly admitted students in 2021
