We have the following units available: Triple room with shared bathroom: 120 eur per month (43 beds available), double room with shared bathroom: 140 eur per month (16 beds available), double room with private bathroom: 180 eur (12 beds available), double private apartment 220 eur per person (one unit available). Prices include all utilities: electricity, heat, hot water, wifi internet. A 100 eur security deposit is required.				
	The Dormitories have four large shared kitchens, as well as study rooms and a leisure room, and wifi internet throughout.				
Visa and Identification Requirements:					
Visa requirements	Citizens of the European Union, member states of the European Economic Area and Swiss Confederation may enter the Republic of Latvia without a visa and stay in Latvia for up to 90 days within a sixmonth period, counting from the day of entry. Citizens from other countries need a longterm visa for exchange students.
