


Study Process



Courses



Our programme is centred around real-world business challenges and offers broad content, covering diverse topics ranging from R programming to Marketing, and from Finance to Ethics.

Students apply the knowledge and skills they gain through various practical study projects and internships. Employers often report that SSE Riga students can make an impact from day one, demonstrating exceptional collaboration skills, which are highly valued in today's job market.

Given the school's relatively small size, with a student body of 450, staff and lecturers can closely engage with each student.

Core courses in the programme combine mainstream economics with aspects of business. These are grouped into five main blocks:

- Economics Courses
- Finance and Accounting Courses
- Business Administration Courses
- Data Analysis and Business Intelligence Courses
- Communication Courses

In the final year, students must select two courses from four specialisation courses:

Economics focuses on the banking system's role in the economy from both micro and macroeconomic perspectives.

Finance delves into financial markets, examining market design, price discovery, liquidity, efficiency, and bubbles, followed by behavioural finance, portfolio management, corporate valuations, and private M&A.

Retail Management provides a general management perspective, covering functions like strategy, online/offline marketing, operations, and supply chain.

Entrepreneurship teaches students how to think and act entrepreneurially, start a new venture, and operate a sustainable business.

International Politics examines complex global political issues, including geostrategy, the arms industry, climate change, and international relations, providing students with a deep understanding of the forces shaping global governance and diplomacy.

In addition to these specialisations, the programme also offers a wide range of **elective courses**, allowing students to further customise their education.

In recent years, an increasing number of SSE Riga graduates chose to pursue Master's degrees at the Stockholm School of Economics in Stockholm.



- Tuition Fee: SSE Riga's tuition fee for the Bachelor's programme is EUR 7,600 per year.
- Tuition Fee Waivers: Students from the European Union, European Economic Area, and European Free Trade Association get a tuition fee waiver of EUR 2,400, lowering their tuition to EUR 5,200 each year.
