If student proficiency level appears to be lower than expected, SSE Riga reserves the right to administer its own test upon arrival. If the results are unsatisfactory, students will be requested to take intensive English course

<b>Dormitories</b>	<p>We are pleased to offer our students accommodation at the SSE Riga Student Dormitories. The dormitories are located at Patversmes iela 22, Riga, and are about 20 minutes by bus from SSE Riga. The prices range from 220 - 350 EUR per month. Prices include all utilities: electricity, heat, hot water, Wi-Fi internet, and kitchen facilities. The prices listed are in effect for the 2025/26 academic year and are subject to change for the following academic year. <b><u>Visa and Identification Requirements:</u></b>	
<b>Visa requirements</b>	<p>- Citizens of the European Union, member states of the European Economic Area and Swiss Confederation may enter the Republic of Latvia without a visa and stay in Latvia for up to 90 days within a six-month period, counting from the day of entry.</p> <p>Citizens from other countries need a long-term visa for an exchange semester (<a href="http://www.pmlp.gov.lv/en/home/services/visas-and-invitations/#1">http://www.pmlp.gov.lv/en/home/services/visas-and-invitations/#1</a>).</p> <p>All third-country nationals, who have not been issued a visa or residence permit in Latvia, are obliged to submit certain information regarding themselves, their relatives (if any) and the purpose of travel to the State threat prevention information system (<a href="https://eta.gov.lv/en/">https://eta.gov.lv/en/</a>) before entering Latvia.</p>

<b>Food (per month)</b>	EUR 400-450
<b>Local Transportation (type and cost/month)</b>	Riga has a well-developed public transportation system. A one-way ticket on any kind of public transport costs EUR 1,50
